### **HOST A THREE LITTLE PIGS PARTY!**

### **GETTING STARTED**

Not all little pigs knows how to plan for big events! Here are some tips to help make your party go as smoothly as possible.

Choose a date and time for your event and announce it on your newsletter and/or website. Remember, younger children have shorter attention spans and get tired more easily. We suggest your party last no more than an hour.

Make copies of the **INVITATION** (**REPRODUCIBLE A**) and fold each sheet into quarters so that "You're Invited" appears on the front. Hand out the invitations, keep a stack next to the register, and/or send them to those on your mailing list. Use the **STORE EVENT SIGN** (**REPRODUCIBLE B**), in addition to the invitation. Feature it next to the register or in your window. Feature the poster and window cling in your store window, too.

Make copies of the **COLORING AND ACTIVITY SHEETS** (**REPRODUCIBLE C - H**) and the **ANSWER KEY** (**REPRODUCIBLE I**) and be sure to have plenty of crayons and pencils available. Also, no party is complete without giveaways, so your kit includes 20 **STICKER SHEETS**! Hand them out during activity time, or after your event to thank everyone for coming.

In addition, here are some fun ideas to help you make sure everyone has a good time.



# THE THREE LITTLE PIGS ACTIVITY PLANNER

#### SET THE SCENE

When it comes to decorating, feel free to go hog wild! Find inspiration from the book and carry the Three Little Pigs theme throughout your event space and window display. Create a barnyard scene and color scheme or think pink! Decorate with straw (or bales of hay), sticks, and bricks. Have employees and guests dress up as little pigs or the wolf.

#### **Slop Time**

Two of Mark Teague's three little pigs most enjoy potato chips and "sody-pop." But for healthier options, look to the third pig in the story, who prefers sandwiches or fresh garden vegetables. Other ideas? Serve a bowl of pretzel rods for "sticks" or cups of chocolate pudding for "mud."

#### **Story Hour**

Get ready to ham it up! The Three Little Pigs and the Somewhat Bad Wolf is a perfect read-aloud. Find a comfy spot where kids can gather around and ask a volunteer or a member of your staff to read.
